

Refugees in Poland

- The situation of Ukrainians is a topical issue in the world
- Since February 24, the day of the beginning of Russia's aggression, over 3.59 million refugees from Ukraine have already crossed the Polish-Ukrainian border.



Help for Ukrainians Poland

- food and money collection
- help of the inhabitants of Poland (People together organize
 in transports, accommodation and food and clothing collections)
 - •psychological help etc.

Polish school for Ukraine

Children of refugees who find refuge in Poland enroll in Polish schools and overnight start their education in a completely new place. - Those children who do not know the Polish language are first sent to preparatory departments. This is the most friendly situation for them



School support for children from Ukraine

Ukrainian children who are enrolled in primary schools can count on the support of their teachers, for example in the form of extracurricular activities.

Ukrainian children have to pass exams at the end of primary school, including exams in Polish, so teachers teach them the Polish language from scratch during lessons.









Transport for refugees from Ukraine

Refugees from Ukraine are guaranteed free travel on trains and public transport throughout the country on presentation of a valid passport or other document. In addition, vehicles with Ukrainian registration numbers or vehicles providing assistance to Ukrainians are exempt from tolls on certain sections of motorways.



Ukrainian refugees can count on free medical assistance and use a free medical hotline in Polish and Ukrainian. They can also count on psychological support.



PESEL number for Ukrainian citizens

Ukrainian citizens can apply for a PESEL number. The PESEL number entitles you to receive social assistance and any other benefits.

In addition, on many websites the text is written in Polish and Ukrainian.
